Who Should Apply: The Greater Cincinnati GCSA is pleased to inform you that scholarships will be offered to students who are currently enrolled in studies pertaining to the turf industry and / or the son or daughter of a member. The deadline to submit your application is May 15th. The four scholarships are listed below:

Howard Dammel Scholarship (\$2500) - awarded to the most deserving turf student applicant.

Marion Mendenhall Scholarship (\$2500) - awarded to the most academically deserving applicant that is a son/daughter of a Greater Cincinnati GCSA member.

Charlie Tadge Service Award Scholarship (\$2500) - awarded to the most community service driven applicant that is a son/daughter of a Greater Cincinnati GCSA member.

John Fanning Legacy Scholarship (\$2500) - The Fanning family will be awarding a scholarship in the name of John, who recently passed. The recipient will embody the character and passion that John showed in his many years in the turf industry.

A 250 word essay is required of all applicants explaining why you have chosen the turf field or how you have been influenced by your parents' turf profession. Please use the following criteria when submitting applications:

- 1. Applicant must include current grade transcript.
- 2. Applicant must include letter(s) of recommendation.
- 3. Applicant must include a 250 word essay.
- 4. Applicant must include a resume of employment history
- 5. All applicant questions must be answered honestly to the best of the applicant's knowledge.
- 6. Information given on the application must be either typewritten or printed.

The Scholarship Committee will base the selection of qualified candidates on the following:

- Scholastic Achievement
- Turf related job experience (where applicable)
- Strength of Essay
- Past Winner (2 year max)
- Longevity of parents' turf profession, volunteer service to the GCGCSA board, or past history of hosting a GCGCSA Scholarship and Research Outing
- Financial Need
- College/University (online, turf certificate, 2 year, 4 year, etc.)
- High School Achievements and Intent to enroll in a college/university or turf program.
