## Championship Overview

The Women's Western Junior features 78 of the top junior players in the world all vying for the historic Icelly Trophy and various exemptions into elite junior and amateur tournaments.

Players compete in 36 holes of stroke play qualifying before the field is cut to the low 16 for match play. The 2024 championship featured:

- » Players from 24 U.S. states and 8 countries
- » Average handicap of +1.1
- » 31 players committed to compete at the NCAA Division I level
